Carmenere, Chile, 2017

A traditional grape of Bordeaux, adopted and loved by winemakers of Chile. Medium weight with blackberry notes and a peppery tone. Hints of leather and a nice finish, well paired with lighter meat dishes.

Cotes du Rhone, Domaine Andre Brunel, France, 2016

Dry, earthy and smooth. Black pepper, leather and forest fruits on the palate. Mild tannins and a certain minerality, this wine is paired well with beef and game dishes.

Pinot Noir, Stoneburn, New Zealand, 2016

Strawberry and black cherry feature in this earthy red. Combining these flavours with a subtle French oak and a hint of spice, this is a top quality, full, Marlborough Pinot Noir.

Full bodied and velvety, this wine has firm tannins with cherry and oak hints. Deep red in colour with tones of dark fruits. A brilliant example of a bold Australian Shiraz.
